

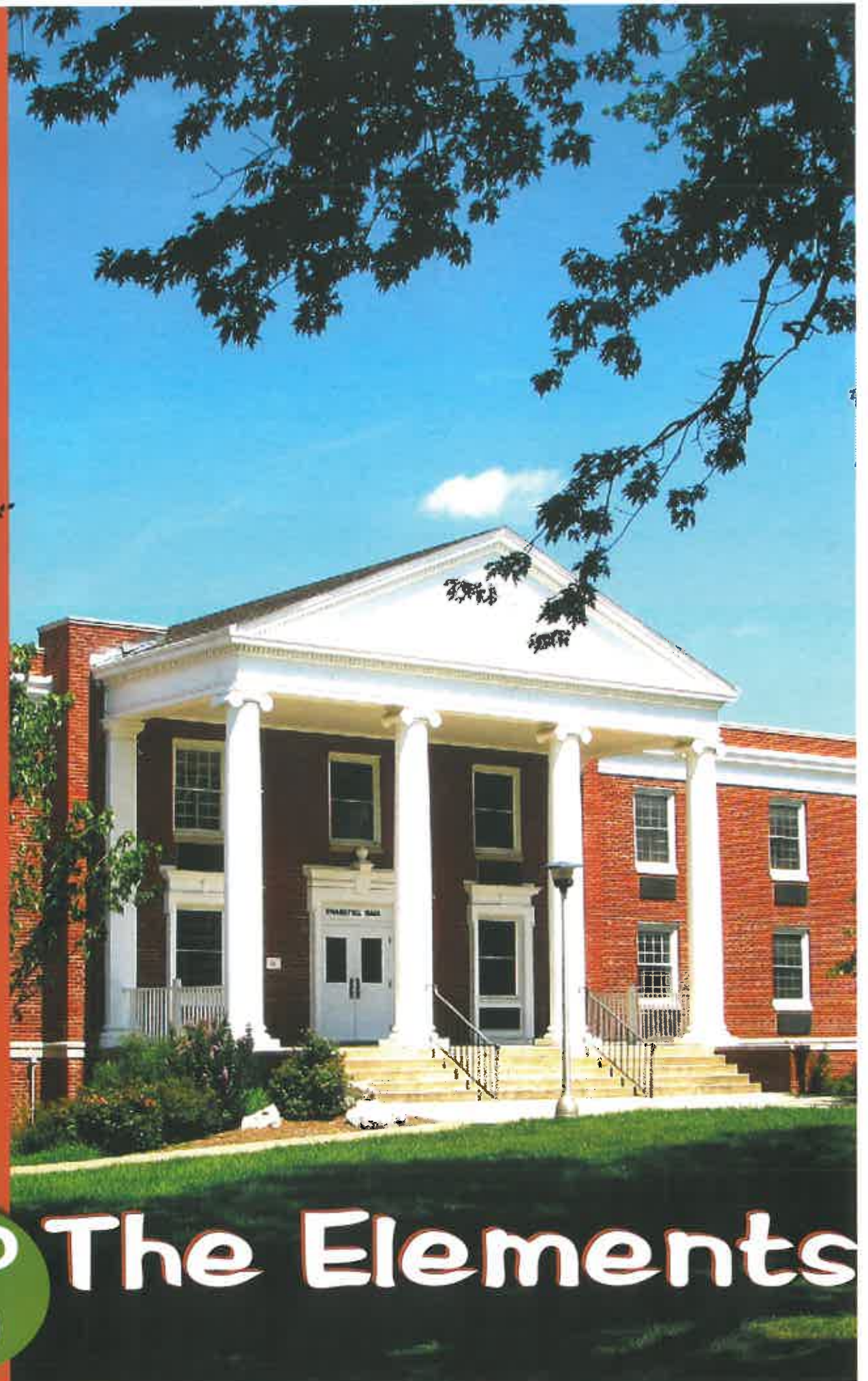

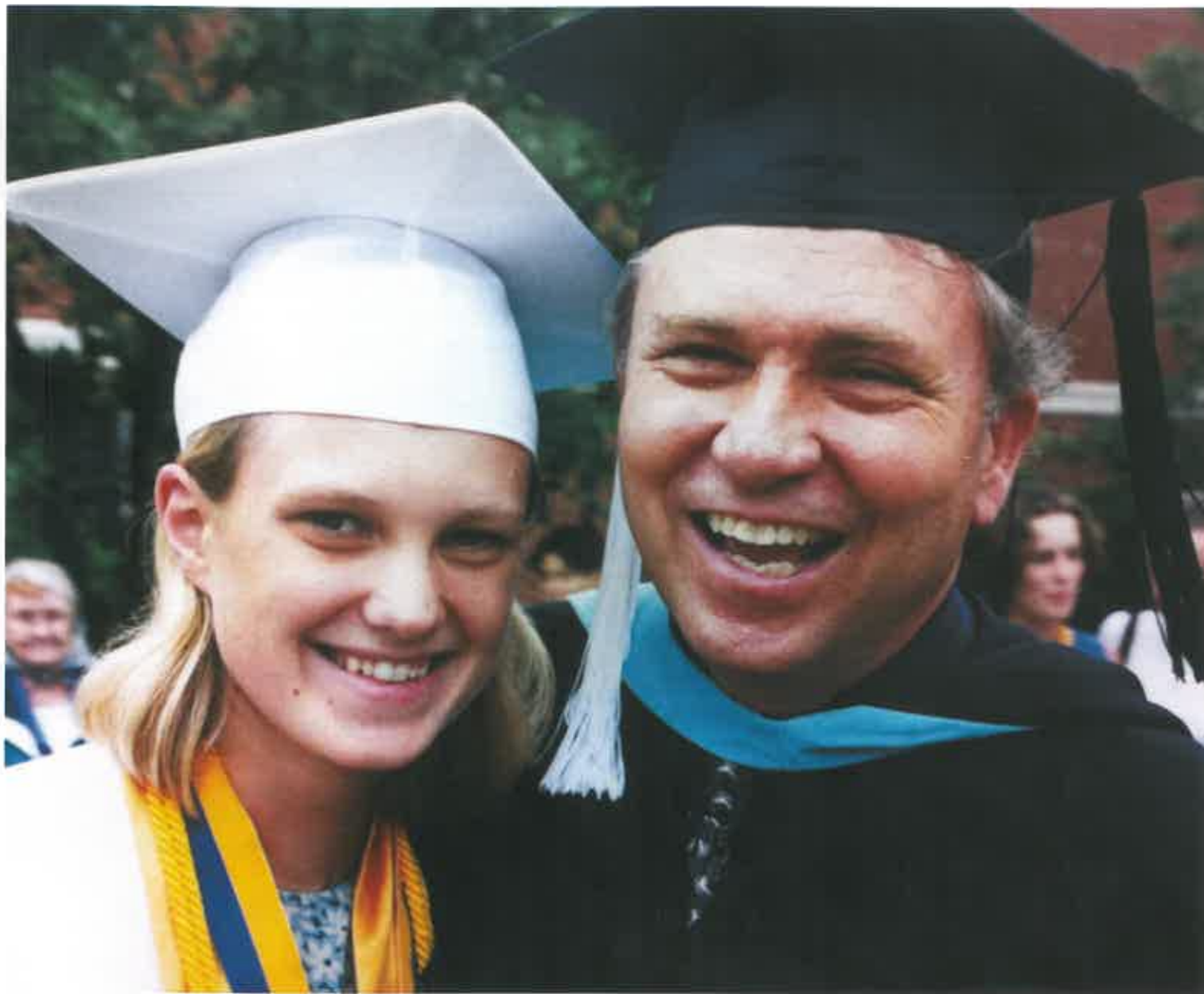
Without Him all these other relationships lack true meaning.

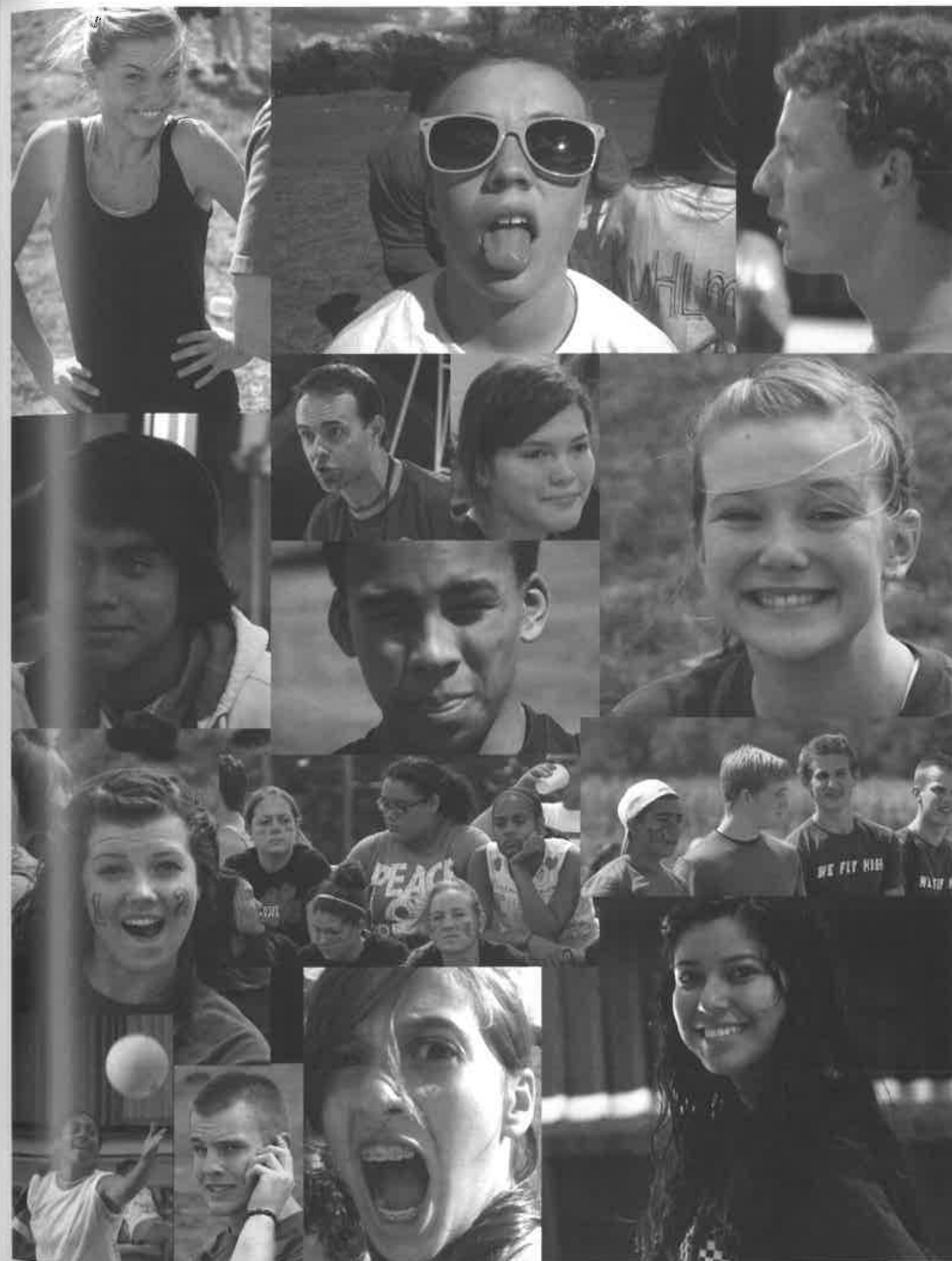
