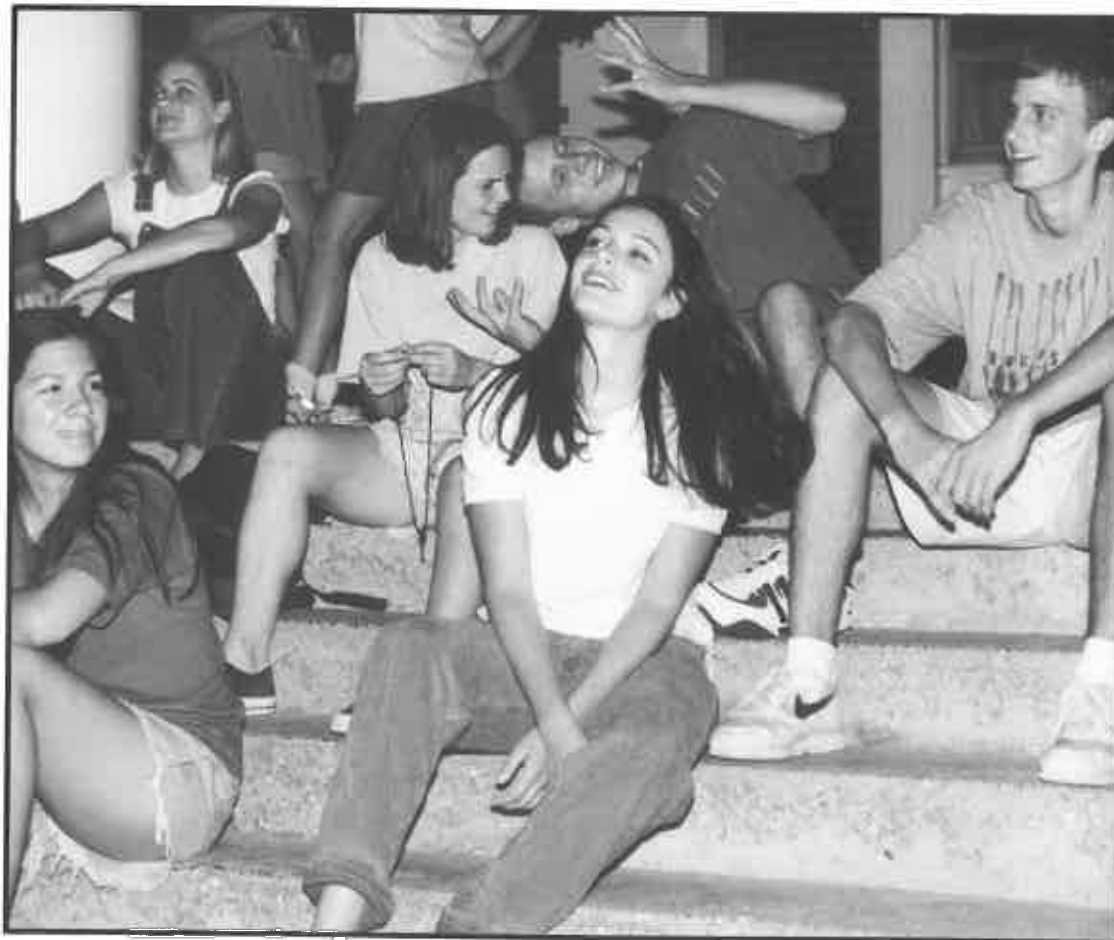

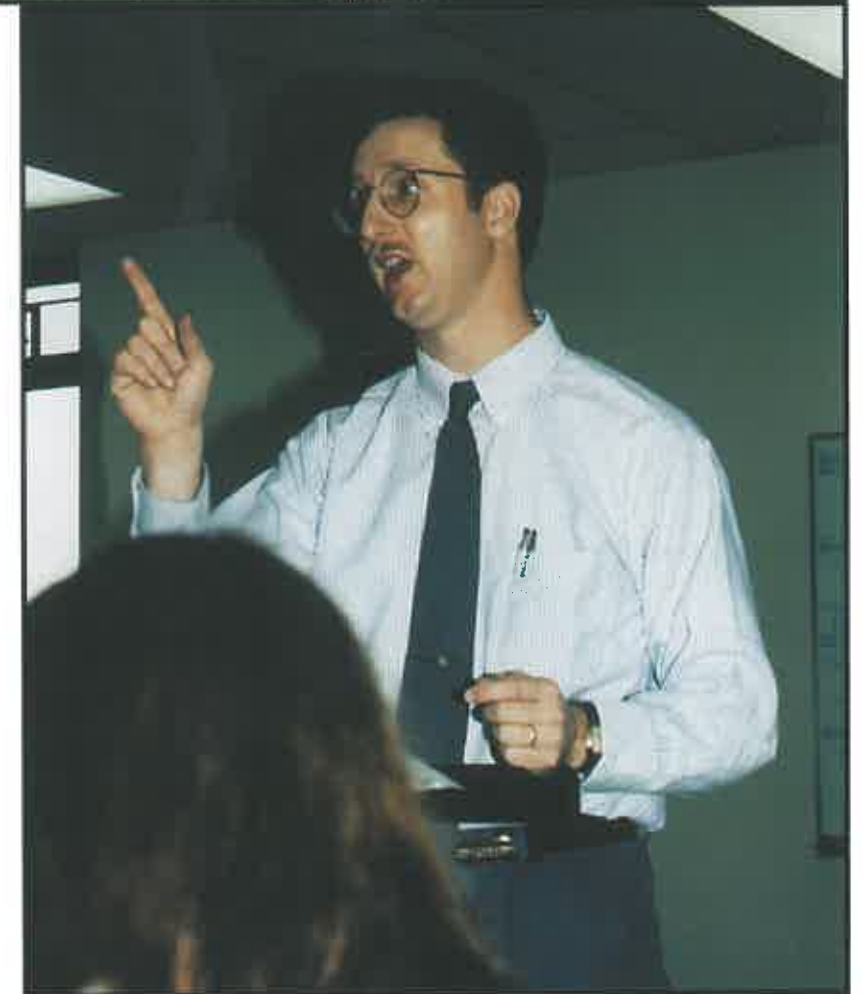
In Dedication... *for your guidance and wisdom*

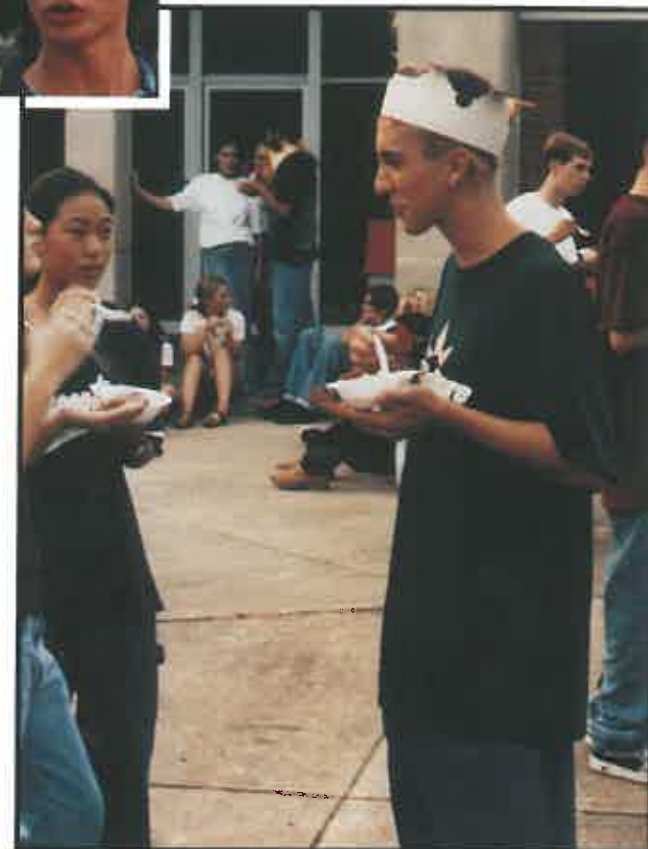

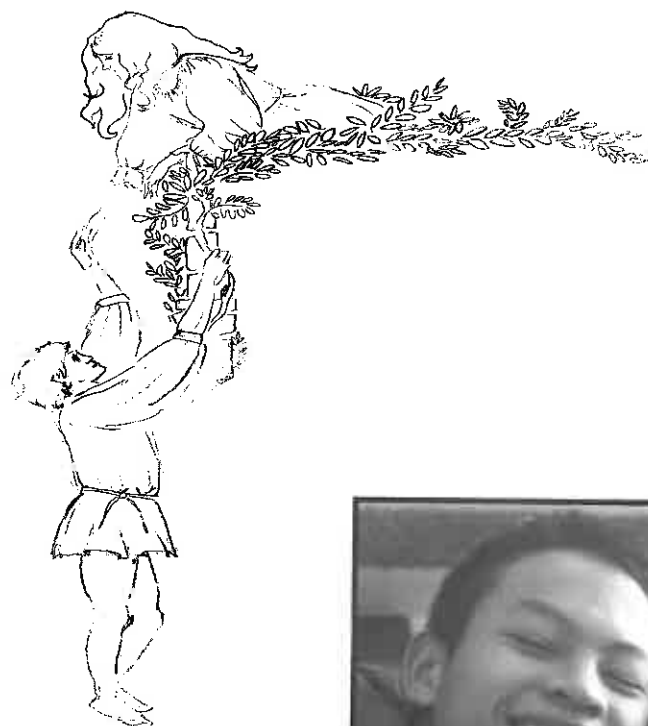
